

# ENTRY REQUIREMENTS COSTA RICA

### Visa Requirements:

• US citizens do not need visas for a stay of less than 90 days. You will need to show your return plane ticket or confirmed flight itinerary upon arrival.

### Passport Requirements:

- Your passport must be valid for the full length of your stay; we recommend it be valid for at least six months past the end of your trip.
- Your passport must be signed.
- Your passport must have at least one blank page marked "Visas."

# Special Requirements for Travelers Under Age 18:

We recommend that travelers under 18 travel with the following documents:

- A photocopy of your birth certificate.
- A photocopy of both parents' passports or driver's licenses.
- A notarized Consent to Travel Statement signed by both parents. A sample letter can be found at <u>www.rusticpathways.com/forms</u>.

# Non-US Citizens:

- Citizens of Canada, Mexico, United Kingdom and the European Union do not require visas for stays of less than 90 days. The passport and minor traveler requirements listed above will apply.
- Citizens of China must acquire a visa in advance through the Costa Rica Embassy in your country of residence. However, citizens of China who hold a valid US visa or Permanent Residency Card do not require visas to visit Costa Rica.
- Citizens of all other nations, please contact G3 to confirm your entry requirements.
