



Visa Requirements for US Citizens:

- Thailand: No visa required for stays of less than 30 days.
- Laos: A tourist visa will be issued upon arrival in Laos.
 - You must bring two identical passport-size photos with you for your visa.
 - The fees for your visa have been included in the cost of your program.

Passport Requirements:

- Your passport must be valid for at least six months past the end of your trip.
- Your passport must be signed.
- Your passport must have at least three blank pages marked “Visas.”

Special Requirements for Travelers Under Age 18:

We recommend that all travelers under age 18 travel with the following documents:

- A photocopy of your birth certificate.
- A photocopy of both parents’ passports or driver’s licenses.
- A notarized Consent to Travel Statement signed by both parents. A sample letter can be found at www.rusticpathways.com/forms.

Non-US Citizens:

- LAOS: Citizens of Canada, China, Mexico, United Kingdom and the European Union will have a tourist visa issued on arrival. All requirements listed above will apply.
- THAILAND: Citizens of Canada, United Kingdom and the European Union do not require visas for stays of less than 30 days. The passport and minor traveler requirements listed above will apply. Citizens of China will acquire a visa on arrival in Thailand; a visa valid 15 days costs 1,000 Thai Baht. Citizens of Mexico must obtain a visa in advance of travel through an embassy or consulate of Thailand. Citizens of all other nations, please contact G3 to confirm your entry requirements.

Required Travel Document Checklist:

- Two identical passport-style photographs for your Laos tourist visa.
- Your valid, signed passport with three blank visa pages.
- Required documentation for travelers under 18 as listed above.
